## Catch, Photo, & Release, Honor System

- Two categories- Game Fish (Pike, Walleye, Bass), and Panfish
  - Due to the trophy size restriction (40 in pike), most fish will have to be measured, photo, and released.
  - Each team will then submit the lengths of their 10 largest game fish and the lengths of their 10 largest panfish.
  - Traveling plaques will be award to the top team in each category and a prize to the overall best team score.
  - Individual prizes for the top three game fish and panfish.
