Mandatory Rules Meeting 6:30 am Central Time at Marinette High School.

Registration: 6:00 – 6:30am. Please contact Luke Maulding to pre-register. Additional teams may be added the day of the tournament. Please bring team rosters, waiver forms, and entry fees to the Mandatory Rules Meeting.

Who: Open to all students grades 7-12. Schools may register multiple teams.

Cost: \$20 per angler - includes meal ticket and student raffle ticket for door prize.

4-Angler Teams: Teams may consist of 1 - 4 student anglers. Schools can have multiple teams. Only 2-anglers per boat. A non-angler adult boat coach/advisor is required. Boats may contain up to 2 non-angler boat coaches/advisors who are there to teach, not fish.

Fishing: Fishing will begin at 7:00am and will end at 3:00pm central time.
Menominee River and the Bay of Green Bay - **Both boat and shore fishing allowed.**

Weigh-in: Weigh-in will be held at **Marinette High School**. Teams must be in line by 3:30pm.

Individual Awards for: (Length will be used to break tie)

- Awards based on weight – **Walleye - Trout** (1st and 2nd Place Awards)

Team Awards for: (Length will be used to break tie)

- Total weight of both species – **Walleye – Trout** (1st – 3rd Place)
- Total combined weight of both species – **Walleye and Trout** (1st – 3rd Place)
 - **Each angler may register 1 Walleye and 3 Trout.**
 - **Each team may register up to 4 Walleye and 12 Trout.**
